Semester / Credit	Second (Fall) / 1	Instructor	Satoshi Hashimoto
Goals	To work in Japan, students will be required "Business Japanese", or vocabulary and concepts of business and social news which are different from Japanese learned in most university classrooms. Also, it is important to know the Japanese necessary to be a member of society, such as the Japanese way of thinking and behavior for smooth communication with Japanese people. In this course, students will learn how to communicate smoothly with Japanese people not only in the university but also in society.		
Overview	Students will learn the basics for effective teamwork in society and learn the process of entering companies from a job offer, as well as the Japanese way of thinking. Also, students will learn business Japanese. Students will read news articles from the "Nikkei Shinbun" and explain the vocabularies while gaining knowledge of business news.
