Application Procedure to Tokushima University For Exchange Students

- 1. Apply for the students exchange program <u>at your home university</u>. And all applicants are required to send the following documents to International Affairs Division in Tokushima University by e-mail and original by EMS;

 e.g. If you enroll from fall semester, fill in only subjects to be opened in fall semester.
 - Personal Resume (download here) (Reference)
 - Health Certificate (download here) (Reference)
 - Academic Record (issued by applicants current university)
 - Copy of Certificate of Japanese Language Skill (If not available, supporting documents concerning applicant's Japanese language proficiency will be required.)
 - Learning schedule including interesting subjects or courses
 (one page with A4- sized paper) Refer to the course syllabuses the below (Item 2)
 - Passport Copy

If your Study abroad at Tokushima University is mainly for research purpose, please submit "Schedule Form of the Study" with your application documents.

Language Requirements

Japanese language proficiency is to be able to take lectures and tests in Japanese without translation.

JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) Level 3 (N3) or higher is desirable.

If applicants do not have a JLPT certificate, supporting documents to prove their Japanese proficiency (being equivalent to or higher than N3) will be required.

Application Deadline

Spring semester: September 30 Fall semester: March 31 2. Select course works for the semester in Tokushima University.

Exchange students are required to register at least 7 courses per week.

Graduate School students are able to choose minimum of 4 courses if "Schedule Form of the Study" is submitted.
